INVITATION FOR A DEBATE ON CANIDROME

It is usual that Canidrome never answers us or any other people that writes complaining about the situation of the greyhounds in the track.

We have met three times in our life, two of them in DICJ in 2012, where you promised us to send a dog to Anima and initiate an adoption program that never went ahead.

During these four years, Canidrome was only able to make one adoption and send three animals for adoption in the Macau Kennel!

Your first adoption was to deceive foolish people, let me be honest with you! Who adopted the animal was your own vet (accompanied by a nice young girl) that has the dog in his own clinic, we suspect for using in blood transfusion!

The other three animals were adopted because of the efforts of the Macau Kennel who did a job that should be done by you.

Several adoptions forms were sent by us to you by registered post and no answer at all! I know that you referred several times in our two official meetings that you prefer to work with another association (now I see that it is AAPAM). You never accepted our draft agreement sent by us to DICJ for an honest and responsible adoption program where Anima had exactly the same obligations as the Canidrome!

We are not jealous of this love affair, however the work done by both should be considered ridiculous: only one animal from your both initiative was adopted by your own vet!

You can joke with ignorant people or may finance AAPAM, that makes noise in the streets trying to convince the community that they care about animals, to divide the field of the animal welfare organizations.

We really don't care too much about what you and they do!
