## Advocating for the closing of Macau Yat Yuen Canidrome

Anima is writing to you and to other animal protection and welfare organizations in Macau to seek your support and act in solidarity to urge our government to end the hardship and suffering of the greyhounds in Macau Yat Yuen Canidrome.

Despite several years of campaigning between Macau Yat Yuen Canidrom, DICJ and IACM officials, and despite the strong support of international animal welfare organizations, Anima is still waiting for a definitive answer from our government. Time is running out before the renewal of Yat Yuen's operation concession; and we are, therefore, intensifying our actions to put more pressure on our Chief Executive's office not to renew the concession when it ends this December

Attached is our "call for action" to all Macau people to take part in our petition exercise. Anima's representatives will be collecting signatures in various locations in Macau from April 11, 2015 to July 23, 2015. These signatures will be tabulated and delivered to our CE's headquarter on the following day.
